COMPOSITE FILLINGS

Our office places only composite fillings on permanent teeth. The resin material used in composite fillings actually bonds to the structure of the treated tooth, providing greater support and a stronger restoration than is possible with amalgam. Furthermore, because composite fillings bond with the actual teeth, there is no space for decay to form, which can be a problem with mercury or metal fillings. Composite fillings also tend to wear better and last longer than amalgam fills. Composite fillings are also significantly healthier for the patient. Amalgam fillings are customarily composed of mercury, which is highly toxic.

COLLECTION FEES
